Town of Taylor Parade Regulations and Liability Waiver

Parade Rules:

- All parade participants must be registered by September 3, 2022.
- All parade entries must be less than 30 feet in length.
- A float is not required for parade participation. Groups of individuals may walk in the parade if they wish.
- Throwing of candy, toys or other objects from floats, trailers or vehicles is strictly prohibited due to the potential for serious injury. Anyone found throwing items from their float, trailer or vehicle will be asked to leave the parade immediately. Participants on foot may distribute candy or other items by handing them to spectators.
- The consumption of alcohol or other illegal substances is strictly prohibited before and during the parade. Anyone suspected of being in violation of this policy will be asked to leave the parade immediately.
- Parade officials have the authority to remove any parade entry for violation of any of the above rules.

Waiver:

The undersigned expressly acknowledges that the activities of the parade (including pre- and post-parade activities) are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury, death and/or property damage. In consideration of the benefits received by myself and/or our organization, as a result of said participation, I/we, together with my/our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby release, waive, and forever discharge and covenant not to sue the Snowflake/Taylor Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Taylor and any sponsors of the Taylor Sweet Corn Festival and its Parade, all of its agents, members, employees, insurers, lessees, lessors, and associates of any status whatsoever, all for the purposes herein referred to as Releasees, from all liability whatsoever.

I/we further agree to indemnify and to hold forever harmless said Releasees from any and all claims, loss, liability, damage or cost that Releasees may incur due to my/our participation, in the above-mentioned event.

I/we hereby assume all responsibility for and risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage due to any act or omission of Releasees while I/we participate in the above-mentioned event.

I/we expressly agree that this release, waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Arizona and that if any portion thereof is held to be invalid, it is expressly agreed that the remainder of this document, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and legal effect.

I/WE HAVE READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNED THE PARADE REGULATIONS AND LIABILITY WAIVER. I/WE HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE RULES OF THE PARADE AND AGREE TO COMPLY UNDER PENALTY OF REMOVAL FROM PARADE ACTIVITIES.
